A meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Colfax County, Nebraska was held in the Commissioners Room of the County Courthouse, Schuyler, Nebraska on the 24th day of October 2023. The County Board of Commissioners met at 8:30 a.m. Present were: Carl Grotelueschen, Jim Mejstrik and Terry V. Wendt, County Commissioners, Rita M. Mundil, County Clerk and Bruce J. Prenda, County Attorney. Notice of this meeting was given in advance thereof by posting written notice in at least three different public places as shown by the Certificate of Posting Notice. The availability of the proposed agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the board. Copies of the Open Meetings Act were posted and available to the public. All proceedings shown were taken while the meeting was officially convened and open to the public.

Motion Mejstrik; second Wendt to approve the agenda. Voting YES: Grotelueschen, Mejstrik and Wendt. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.

Motion Grotelueschen; second Mejstrik to approve the regular minutes of 10/10/2023. Voting YES: Mejstrik, Wendt and Grotelueschen. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.

The Clerk provided the fund balance, August Lodging Tax Revenue, STOP Revenue received, Receipt of reimbursement for Sheriff Deputy training cost and Election Procedures for Voting for NACO Officers. The NACO 2022-2023 fiscal year Audit has been accepted by the NACO Board with a paper copy available on request.

The inmate logs from Butler and Platte County were provided to the board and placed on file.

The Vet Service Officer provided October 10, 2023, claim reimbursements of services for Colfax County Veterans which will be placed on file.

The 3rd quarter CASA report was provided to the board.

Bailey Garretson was introduced to the board. Motion Mejstrik; second Wendt to approve the appointment of Bailey Garretson as Weed Superintendent (part-time – not to exceed a 24-hour work week) with an effective date of October 23, 2023.
