## Minutes

A meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Colfax County, Nebraska was held in the Commissioners Room of the County Courthouse, Schuyler, Nebraska on the 23rd day of January 2024. The County Board of Commissioners met at 8:30 a.m. Present were: Carl Grotelueschen and Jim Mejstrik, County Commissioners, Rita M. Mundil, County Clerk and Bruce J. Prenda, County Attorney. Absent: Terry V. Wendt, County Commissioner. Notice of this meeting was given in advance thereof by posting written notice in at least three different public places as shown by the Certificate of Posting Notice. The availability of the proposed agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the board. Copies of the Open Meetings Act were posted and available to the public. All proceedings shown were taken while the meeting was officially convened and open to the public.

The Chairman stated a copy of the Open Meeting Act statute is posted and available to the public.

The Vet Service Officer provided claim reimbursements for January 16, 2024, which will be placed on file.

The 4<sup>th</sup> quarter CASA report was provided to the board.

It was determined since no deed was filed on the CRP grounds that the contract with Farm Service Agency will serve as the Conservation Easement. No action from the board was taken.
